The school receives extra funding to support children's learning, trips, clubs and experiences – so registering makes a big difference.

Booking opens early for families of children with an Individual Education Plan (IEP), as these appointments are 20 minutes long. For all other parents, booking for your 10-minute appointments will open next week via Scopay.
