- do not block residents' driveways
- avoid parking within 20 metres of a junction, especially at the end of Scholars Drive and the junction between Calvestone Road and Gerard Way
- do not stop on the yellow zigzags
- only parents with disability badges should enter the school car park at busy times

As the temperature drops, please remember warm coats and PE kits suitable for the colder weather (plain black or navy tracksuits). Hats and gloves are very welcome and it's a great help if items are named.

Paths can be slippery, so please take care and stick to the gritted routes when moving around the site.

Home visits and pupil absence

Schools sometimes carry out home visits when a child is absent and we want to explain the reasons so families know why this may happen.

Our first step is always to try to contact parents or carers by phone or message. If we cannot reach anyone, or if the absence needs a little more clarity, a home visit may be appropriate. This might include situations such as:

- no explanation for a child's absence
- we have been unable to make contact after several attempts
- the child is already a persistent absentee (attendance below 90%)
- the pattern of absence is unusual or gives us cause to check on welfare

The purpose of a home visit is to make sure the child is safe and well and that parents are aware they are not in school. It is not about challenging families. It is a routine safeguarding step taken with care and respect.

Our priority is the welfare of children and we would rather check than risk missing a situation where support is needed. Thank you for your understanding as we work together to keep every child safe and well.
